## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- SECTION 1. Chapter 372, Transportation Code, is amended by 4
- 5 adding Sections 372.054 and 372.055 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 372.054. USE OF TRANSPONDERS. (a) In this section,
- "transponder" means a device, placed on or in a motor vehicle, that 7
- is capable of transmitting information used to assess or to collect 8
- 9 tolls.
- 10 (b) A toll project entity shall waive any fees and penalties
- for the failure to pay a toll while driving or towing a vehicle 11
- 12 through a toll booth or toll plaza if:
- 13 (1) a transponder registered to the vehicle and
- 14 associated with the vehicle's license plate was used when the
- vehicle was driven or towed through the toll booth or plaza; 15
- 16 (2) the failure to collect the tolls is due solely to
- transponder or toll equipment error, including failure to read a 17

- (4) any transponder error was not due to damage to the 20

- (c) A toll project entity that waives fees and penalties 22

- 15 project entity shall adopt a rule or order, as applicable, waiving
- 16 penalties and fees associated with a failure to pay a toll while
- 17 driving through a toll booth or toll plaza if:
- 18 (1) the toll booth or toll plaza at which the vehicle
- 19 operator failed to pay the toll allowed for payment only through the
- 20 use of a transponder and toll payment by mail is not a payment

- 22 (2) the registered owner had not previously failed to
