1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the effect of a delay by the State Board for Educator
1-11 Certification in renewing an educator's certification.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 21.0031, Education Code, is amended by
1-14 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:

1-15 (f) For purposes of this section, a certificate or permit is
1-16 not considered to have expired if:

1-17 (1) the employee has completed the requirements for
1-18 renewal of the certificate or permit;

1-19 (2) the employee submitted the request for renewal
1-20 prior to the expiration date; and

1-21 (3) the date the certificate or permit would have
1-22 expired is before the date the State Board for Educator
1-23 Certification takes action to approve the renewal of the
1-24 certificate or permit.

1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-28 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-29 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
