- 8 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER. (a) An individual may purchase a firearm from
- 9 a county if:
- 10 (1) the individual was a peace officer commissioned by
- 11 the county who is honorably retired;
- 12 (2) the firearm had been previously issued to the
- 13 <u>individual by the county; and</u>
- 14 (3) the firearm is not a prohibited weapon under
- 15 Section 46.05, Penal Code.
- 16 (b) An individual may purchase only one firearm from a
- 17 county under this section.
- (c) The county commissioners court shall establish the
- 19 <u>amount, which may not exceed fair market</u> value, for which a firearm
- 20 may be purchased under this section.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
