- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 17, Civil Practice and
- 6 Remedies Code, is amended by adding Section 17.029 to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Sec. 17.029. SERVICE ON INMATE OF TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF
- 9 CRIMINAL JUSTICE. (a) In this section, "inmate" means a person
- 10 confined in a facility operated by or under contract with the Texas
- 11 Department of Criminal Justice.
- 12 (b) In a civil action against an inmate, citation or other
- 13 civil process may be served on the inmate by serving a person
- 14 designated under Subsection (c) as an agent for service of civil
- 15 process.
- 16 (c) The warden of each facility operated by or under
- 17 contract with the Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall
- 18 designate an employee at the facility to serve as an agent for
- 19 service of civil process on inmates confined in the facility.
- 20 <u>(d) An employee designated under Subsection (c) as an agent</u>
- 21 for service of civil process shall promptly deliver any civil
- 22 process served on the employee to the appropriate inmate.
- SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2011, the warden of
- 24 each facility operated by or under contract with the Texas

- 1 Department of Criminal Justice shall designate an employee at the
- 2 facility to serve as an agent for service of civil process as
- 3 required by Section 17.029, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, as
- 4 added by this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
