- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 822.005, Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), an [An] offense
- 9 under this section is a felony of the third degree [unless the
- 10 attack causes death, in which event the offense is a felony of the
- 11 second degree].
- 12 (b-1) An offense under this section is a felony of the
- 13 second degree if the attack causes death, except that the offense is
- 14 a felony of the first degree if the attack causes death to a person:
- 15 (1) younger than 18 years of age; or
- 16 (2) 65 years of age or older.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 20 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 21 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 22 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 23 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 24 before that date.
