5 SECTION 1. Section 822.005, Health and Safety Code, is 6 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to 7 read as follows:

8 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), an [An] offense 9 under this section is a felony of the third degree [unless the 10 attack causes death, in which event the offense is a felony of the 11 second degree].

12 (b-1) An offense under this section is a felony of the 13 second degree if the attack causes death, except that the offense is 14 a felony of the first degree if the attack causes death to a person:

- 15 (1) younger than 18 years of age; or
- 16

(2) 65 years of age or older.

SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 18 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 19 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 20 21 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 23 before that date. 24
