- SECTION 1. Section 822.005, Health and Safety Code, 5 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (b-1) to 6 read as follows: 7
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (b-1), an [An] offense 8 under this section is a felony of the third degree [unless the 9 attack causes death, in which event the offense is a felony of the 10 11 second degree].
- 12 (b-1) An offense under this section is a felony of the second degree if the attack causes death, except that the offense is 13 14 a felony of the first degree if the attack causes death to a person:
- (1) younger than 15 years of age; or 15
- 16 (2) 65 years of age or older.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 18
- An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 19
- governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 20
- 21 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 22
- effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 23
- before that date. 24
