A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to prohibiting nonjudicial foreclosure by a property owners' association on residences owned by certain members of the 3 4 military. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Section 51.002, Property Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (i) to read as follows: (i) Notice served under Subsection (b)(3) or (d) must state 8 9 the name and address of the sender of the notice and contain a statement that is conspicuous, printed in boldface or underlined 10 type, and substantially similar to the following: "If you are or 11 your spouse is serving on active military duty, including active 12 military duty as a member of the Texas National Guard or the 13 National Guard of another state or as a member of a reserve 14 component of the armed forces of the Unites States, please send 15 16 written notice of the active duty military service to the sender of this notice immediately." 17 SECTION 2. Section 51.015(a), Property Code, is amended by 18 adding Subdivision (1-a) to read as follows: 19 (1-a) "Assessment" and "regular assessment" have the 20 meanings assigned by Section 209.002. 21 SECTION 3. Section 51.015(b), Property Code, is amended 22 to 23 read as follows: (b) This section applies only to an obligation: 24

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(1) that is secured by a mortgage, deed of trust, or
other contract lien, including an assessment or regular assessment,
on real property or personal property that is a dwelling owned by a
military servicemember;

5 (2) that originates before the date on which the 6 servicemember's active duty military service commences; and

7 (3) for which the servicemember is still obligated. 8 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to the levy of an assessment or regular assessment as described by 9 Section 51.015, Property Code, as amended by this Act, the 10 effective date of which is on or after the effective date of this 11 Act. A levy of an assessment or regular assessment the effective 12 date of which is before the effective date of this Act is governed 13 by the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of 14 15 this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 16 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
