A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to combination resident hunting and fishing licenses for

- 3 military personnel.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 50.001, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (c-1) The commission shall waive the fee for a qualified
- 8 disabled veteran as defined by Section 42.012 or a resident who
- 9 holds a valid military identification card and is on active duty in
- 10 the United States military forces or is actively participating in
- 11 the Texas Army National Guard, the Texas Air National Guard, or the
- 12 Texas State Guard under the rules established by the adjutant
- 13 general of the state military forces. For the purposes of this
- 14 section, a valid military identification card issued by the Texas
- 15 Army National Guard, the Texas Air National Guard, or the Texas
- 16 State Guard is sufficient to establish residency in this state.
- 17 This subsection does not apply to a person who is retired from the
- 18 military or the dependent of military personnel unless the person
- 19 otherwise qualifies as provided by this subsection.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
