A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the authority of the Childress County Hospital District
3	to provide facilities and services for persons who are elderly or
4	disabled; providing authority to issue bonds and notes.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 1012, Special District
7	Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 1012.114 to read as
8	follows:
9	Sec. 1012.114. FACILITIES OR SERVICES FOR PERSONS WHO ARE
10	ELDERLY OR DISABLED. (a) The district may:
11	(1) purchase, construct, acquire, repair, renovate,
12	equip, or administer the following types of facilities or services
13	for the care of persons who are elderly or disabled:
14	(A) a nursing home or similar long-term care
15	<pre>facility;</pre>
16	(B) elderly housing;
17	(C) assisted living;
18	(D) home health;
19	(E) personal care;
20	(F) special care; or
21	(G) continuing care; and
22	(2) purchase, acquire, repair, or equip durable
23	medical equipment to provide services to persons who are elderly or
24	disabled.

- 1 (b) For a facility or service described by Subsection (a),
- 2 the board may:
- 3 (1) lease or enter into an operating or management
- 4 agreement relating to all or part of a facility or service that is
- 5 owned by the district;
- 6 (2) close, transfer, sell, or otherwise convey all or
- 7 part of a facility; and
- 8 (3) discontinue all or part of a service.
- 9 (c) The board may issue general obligation bonds, revenue
- 10 bonds, and other notes to acquire, construct, or improve a facility
- 11 for the care of persons who are elderly or disabled or to implement
- 12 the delivery of a service for the care of persons who are elderly or
- 13 disabled.
- 14 (d) For the purposes of this section, a facility or service
- 15 described by Subsection (a) is a hospital project under Chapter
- 16 223, Health and Safety Code, notwithstanding Section 223.002 of
- 17 that chapter.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
