2 (3) make recommendations for providing the tort protection described by Subdivision (1) 3 liability of this subsection, including proposed legislative changes necessary to 4 5 implement the recommendations, and specify the estimated costs of 6 implementing the recommendations.

7 (d) The department shall submit the report required by8 Subsection (a) of this section not later than December 1, 2012, to:

9

(1) the governor;

10 (2) the lieutenant governor;

11 (3) the speaker of the house of representatives;

12 (4) the chair of the House Committee on Culture,13 Recreation, and Tourism; and

14 (5) the chair of the Senate Committee on Natural 15 Resources.

16

(e) This section expires September 1, 2013.

17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
