- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 39.03, Penal Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (d) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor,
- 9 unless at the time of the commission of the offense the actor was a
- 10 licensed peace officer and the actor intentionally or knowingly
- 11 caused bodily injury to another, in which event it is a felony of
- 12 the third degree.
- (e) If conduct constituting an offense under this section
- 14 also constitutes an offense under another section of this code, the
- 15 actor may be prosecuted under either section or both sections.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 20 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 21 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 22 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
