1-8 relating to the grounds for revocation of an emergency medical  
1-9 services personnel certification.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 773.0614(c), Health and Safety Code, is  
1-12 amended to read as follows:

1-13 (c) A certificate holder's certificate shall be revoked if  
1-14 the certificate holder has been [~~is~~] convicted of or placed on  
1-15 deferred adjudication community supervision or deferred  
1-16 disposition for:

1-17 (1) an offense listed in Sections 3g(a)(1)(A) through  
1-18 (H), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal Procedure; or

1-19 (2) an offense, other than an offense described by  
1-20 Subdivision (1), committed on or after September 1, 2009, for which  
1-21 the person is subject to registration under Chapter 62, Code of  
1-22 Criminal Procedure.

1-23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
