- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 56, Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, is amended by adding Article 56.031 to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 56.031. ORAL STATEMENT RELATING TO VICTIM IMPACT. (a)
- 8 After a court enters a finding of guilt, but before the imposition
- 9 of a sentence by the court, the court shall permit a victim, close
- 10 relative of a deceased victim, or guardian of a victim to appear in
- 11 open court to present to the court an oral statement about the
- 12 offense and the effect of the offense on the victim.
- 13 <u>(b) The court shall consider the oral statement before</u>
- 14 sentencing the defendant.
- 15 (c) The court may permit the defendant or the attorney
- 16 representing the defendant an opportunity to introduce testimony or
- 17 other information alleging a factual inaccuracy in the oral
- 18 statement.
- 19 (d) The presentation and consideration of an oral statement
- 20 under this article is in addition to the consideration of a written
- 21 victim impact statement under Article 56.03 and does not preclude
- 22 the presentation of a statement after sentence is pronounced under
- 23 Article 42.03.
- 24 (e) Except as provided by Subsection (f), this article

- 1 applies to an adjudication of guilt in a criminal case regardless of
- 2 whether the defendant previously received a deferral of that
- 3 <u>adjudication under Section 5, Article 42.12.</u>
- 4 (f) This article does not apply if punishment is to be
- 5 assessed by a jury.
- 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 7 to a sentencing proceeding that commences on or after the effective
- 8 date of this Act. A sentencing proceeding that commences before the
- 9 effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the
- 10 sentencing proceeding commenced, and the former law is continued in
- 11 effect for that purpose.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
