A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to allowing the commissioners court of a county to
- 3 deliberate in a closed meeting regarding business and financial

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 551.0725(a), Government Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The commissioners court of a county [with a population
- 9 of 400,000 or more] may conduct a closed meeting to deliberate
- 10 business and financial issues relating to a contract being
- 11 negotiated if, before conducting the closed meeting:
- 12 (1) the commissioners court votes unanimously that
- 13 deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on
- 14 the position of the commissioners court in negotiations with a
- 15 third person; and
- 16 (2) the attorney advising the commissioners court
- 17 issues a written determination that deliberation in an open meeting
- 18 would have a detrimental effect on the position of the
- 19 commissioners court in negotiations with a third person.
- 20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 21 to a meeting held on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 22 meeting held before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 23 the law in effect on the date the meeting is held, and the former law
- 24 is continued in effect for that purpose.

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
