Article 18.01(i), Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (i) In a county with a population of less than 100,000 [that does not have a judge of a municipal court of record who is an 8 attorney licensed by the state, a county court judge who is an 9 attorney licensed by the state, or a statutory county court judge], 10 11 any magistrate may issue a search warrant under Subdivision (10) or 12 Subdivision (12) of Article 18.02 of this code. This subsection is not applicable to a subsequent search warrant under Subdivision 13 14 (10) of Article 18.02 of this code. SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 15 to a warrant issued on or after the effective date of this Act. A 16 warrant issued before the effective date of this Act is governed by 17 the law in effect on the date the warrant was issued, and the former 18 law is continued in effect for that purpose. 19 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
