2	relating to an electronic record of eligibility for Medicaid
3	benefits.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 531.0451 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 531.0451. ELECTRONIC RECORD OF ELIGIBILITY. The
8	executive commissioner shall adopt rules to establish a system by
9	which a Medicaid recipient's eligibility for benefits, including
10	medical care identification information, is electronically coded
11	to a card similar to the Lone Star card. The rules must provide for
12	the following:
13	(1) after making an initial eligibility
14	determination, the commission shall include the card in the
15	materials mailed to the recipient with the written notice of
16	eligibility;
17	(2) the recipient's periodic eligibility
18	redetermination is electronically coded to the card; and
19	(3) the card replaces any eligibility redetermination
20	notice, Form H3087, or other written notice of continuing
21	eligibility.
22	SECTION 2. The executive commissioner of the Health and
23	Human Services Commission shall adopt rules required by Section
24	531.0451, Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than

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1 December 31, 2011.

2 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act 3 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 4 federal agency is necessary for the implementation of that 5 provision, the agency affected by the provision shall request the 6 waiver or authorization and may delay implementing that provision 7 until the waiver or authorization is granted.

8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
