| 12 | (B) the Texas National Guard as defined by |

| 16 | (b) The department shall include the designation "VETERAN" |
| 17 | on a driver's license issued to a veteran in an available space |

- (2) the veteran provides proof of the veteran's 21

- SECTION 2. Section 521.142, Transportation Code, is amended 23

- 1 (i) The application must provide space for the applicant:
- 2 (1) to voluntarily list any military service that may
- 3 qualify the applicant to receive a license with a veteran's
- 4 <u>designation under Section 521.1235; and</u>
- 5 (2) to include proof required by the department to
- 6 determine the applicant's eligibility to receive that designation.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
