- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Sections 3807.052(a) and (b), Special District 5
- Local Laws Code, are amended to read as follows: 6
- 7 (a) The mayor and members of the governing body of the City
- of Houston shall appoint directors from persons recommended by the 8
- [Notwithstanding Subchapter D, Chapter 375, Local 9 board.
- Government Code, to be qualified to serve as director, a person must 10
- 11 be at least 18 years of age and:
- [(1) be a resident of the district; or 12
- 13 [(2) have a district business interest.]
- 14 (b) Appointments to the board must ensure that [+
- 15  $[\frac{(1)}{(1)}]$  at least one-third  $[\frac{60 \text{ percent}}{(1)}]$  of the directors
- are residents of the district[; and 16
- [(2) each director who does not reside in the district 17
- has a district business interest]. 18
- SECTION 2. Section 3807.052(c), Special District Local Laws 19
- Code, is repealed. 20
- 21 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 22 only to a person appointed to the board of directors of the Greater
- 23 East End Management District on or after the effective date of this
- 24 Act.

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1 (b) The change in law made by this Act does not affect the
2 right of a person appointed to the board of directors of the Greater
3 East End Management District before the effective date of this Act
4 to continue to serve on the board until the person's term expires.
5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
