1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the board of directors of the Greater East End
1-10 Management District.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Sections 3807.052(a) and (b), Special District
1-13 Local Laws Code, are amended to read as follows:

1-14 (a) The mayor and members of the governing body of the City
1-15 of Houston shall appoint directors from persons recommended by the
1-16 board. ~~[Notwithstanding Subchapter D, Chapter 375, Local
1-17 Government Code, to be qualified to serve as director, a person must
1-18 be at least 18 years of age and:~~

1-19 ~~[(1) be a resident of the district, or~~

1-20 ~~[(2) have a district business interest.]~~

1-21 (b) Appointments to the board must ensure that [+

1-22 ~~[(1)] at least one-third [60 percent] of the directors
1-23 are residents of the district[, and~~

1-24 ~~[(2) each director who does not reside in the district
1-25 has a district business interest].~~

1-26 SECTION 2. Section 3807.052(c), Special District Local Laws
1-27 Code, is repealed.

1-28 SECTION 3. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
1-29 only to a person appointed to the board of directors of the Greater
1-30 East End Management District on or after the effective date of this
1-31 Act.

1-32 (b) The change in law made by this Act does not affect the
1-33 right of a person appointed to the board of directors of the Greater
1-34 East End Management District before the effective date of this Act
1-35 to continue to serve on the board until the person's term expires.

1-36 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-37 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-38 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-39 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-40 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
