2	relating to the creation of DNA records for the DNA database system.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 411.1471, Government
5	Code, is amended to read as follows:
6	Sec. 411.1471. DNA RECORDS OF PERSONS CHARGED WITH OR
7	CONVICTED OF CERTAIN OFFENSES [FELONIES].
8	SECTION 2. Sections 411.1471(a) and (f), Government Code,
9	are amended to read as follows:
10	(a) This section applies to a defendant who is:
11	(1) indicted or waives indictment for a felony
12	prohibited or punishable under any of the following Penal Code
13	sections:
14	(A) Section 20.04(a)(4);
15	(B) Section 21.11;
16	(C) Section 22.011;
17	(D) Section 22.021;
18	(E) Section 25.02;
19	(F) Section 30.02(d);
20	(G) Section 43.05;
21	(H) Section 43.25;
22	(I) Section 43.26; or
23	(J) Section 21.02;
24	(2) arrested for any offense punishable as a Class B

- 1 misdemeanor or any higher category of offense [a felony described
- 2 by Subdivision (1) after having been previously convicted of or
- 3 placed on deferred adjudication for an offense described by
- 4 Subdivision (1) or an offense punishable under Section 30.02(c)(2),
- 5 Penal Code]; or
- 6 (3) convicted of or placed on deferred adjudication
- 7 for an offense under Section 21.07 or 21.08, Penal Code.
- 8 (f) A defendant who provides a DNA sample under this section
- 9 is not required to provide a DNA sample under Section 411.148 unless
- 10 an attorney representing the state [in the prosecution of felony
- 11 offenses] establishes to the satisfaction of the director that the
- 12 interests of justice or public safety require that the defendant
- 13 provide additional samples.
- 14 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 15 to a person arrested for an offense committed on or after the
- 16 effective date of this Act. A person arrested for an offense
- 17 committed before the effective date of this Act is covered by the
- 18 law in effect when the offense was committed, and the former law is
- 19 continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section,
- 20 an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if
- 21 any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
