- 8 may sell, offer for sale, or deliver any liquor:
- 9 (1) on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas
- 10 Day; <u>or</u>
- 11 (2) [<del>on Sunday; or</del>
- 12  $[\frac{(3)}{}]$  before 10 a.m. or after 9 p.m. on any other day.
- 13 [(b) When Christmas Day or New Year's Day falls on a Sunday,
- 14 Subsection (a) of this section applies to the following Monday.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 105.02, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 105.02. HOURS OF SALE: WHOLESALERS AND LOCAL
- 18 DISTRIBUTORS TO RETAILERS. (a) A holder of a wholesaler's permit
- 19 may sell, offer for sale, or deliver liquor to a retailer anytime
- 20 except [Sunday and] Christmas Day.
- 21 (b) A local distributor's permittee may sell, offer for
- 22 sale, or deliver liquor to a retailer between 5 a.m. and 9 p.m. on

- 1  $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$  Christmas Day; or
- 2 (2) a day on which a package store permittee is
