- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 41.0052(a) and (a-1), Election Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) [The governing body of a political subdivision other
- 8 than a county may, not later than December 31, 2005, change the date
- 9 on which it holds its general election for officers to another
- 10 authorized uniform election date.
- 11  $\left[\frac{(a-1)}{a-1}\right]$  The governing body of a political subdivision,
- 12 other than a county, that holds its general election for officers on
- 13 a date other than the November uniform election date may, not later
- 14 than December 31, 2012 [2010], change the date on which it holds its
- 15 general election for officers to the November uniform election
- 16 date.
- 17 SECTION 2. Section 41.0053, Election Code, is repealed.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
