7	SECTION 1. Chapter 2113, Government Code, is amended by
8	adding Subchapter F to read as follows:

10	Sec. 2113.351. CITIZENSHIP INFORMATION. A person,
11	including a state agency, political subdivision of this state,
12	nonprofit organization, or public or private entity, who receives
13	any appropriated money from the state to provide a health care,
14	educational, welfare, correctional, or other service to an
15	<pre>individual in this state shall:</pre>
16	(1) identify the individual's country of citizenship
17	before providing the service to the individual;
18	(2) determine the cost to this state of providing the
19	service to the individual if the individual is a citizen of a
20	foreign country; and
21	(3) submit to the comptroller in the format and within

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- 1 Sec. 2113.352. REPORT AND REIMBURSEMENT. From the
- 2 information collected under Section 2113.351 and under Section
- 3 140.008, Local Government Code, the comptroller at least annually
- 4 shall:
- 5 (1) compile a report that lists by country the total
- 6 amount of money spent by this state and any political subdivision of
- 7 this state to provide services to the citizens of each foreign
- 8 country and details the services provided by category of service
- 9 and political subdivision;
- 10 (2) submit a copy of the report compiled under
- 11 Subdivision (1) to the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker
- 12 of the house of representatives; and
- 13 (3) submit to each foreign country identified in the

- 18 Notwithstanding any other law, the comptroller may not disburse any
- 19 money to a person, including a state agency, political subdivision
- 20 of this state, nonprofit organization, or public or private entity,
- 21 who is subject to Section 2113.351 and who fails to comply with the
- 22 requirements of this subchapter.
- Sec. 2113.354. RULES. The comptroller by rule shall
- 24 prescribe the format and time for submitting the report required
- 25 under Section 2113.351 and adopt any other rules necessary to
- 26 implement this subchapter.
- 27 SECTION 2. Chapter 140, Local Government Code, is amended

- 1 by adding Section 140.008 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 140.008. CITIZENSHIP INFORMATION. (a) A person,
- 3 <u>including a political subdivision of this state</u>, nonprofit
- 4 organization, or public or private entity, who receives local or
- 5 state money to provide a health care, educational, welfare,
- 6 correctional, or other service to an individual in a political
- 7 subdivision of this state shall:
- 8 (1) identify the individual's country of citizenship
- 9 before providing the service to the individual;
- 10 (2) determine the cost to this state and the political
- 11 subdivision of providing the service to the individual if the
- 12 individual is a citizen of a foreign country; and
- 13 (3) submit to the political subdivision and to the
- 14 comptroller in the format and within the time required by
- 15 comptroller rule the information required under Subdivisions (1)
- 16 and (2) and any other information required by comptroller rule.
- 17 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, the comptroller or
- 18 political subdivision may not disburse any money to a person,
- 19 including a political subdivision of this state, nonprofit
- 20 organization, or public or private entity, who fails to comply with
- 21 the requirements of this section and comptroller rules.
- (c) The comptroller by rule shall prescribe the format and
- 23 time for submitting the report required under this section and
- 24 adopt any other rules necessary to implement this section.
- SECTION 3. (a) Not later than December 1, 2011, the
- 26 comptroller of public accounts shall:
- 27 (1) prescribe the format and time for submitting:

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- 1 (A) the report required under Section 2113.351,
- 2 Government Code, as added by this Act; and
- 3 (B) the report required under Section 140.008,
- 4 Local Government Code, as added by this Act; and
- 5 (2) adopt rules necessary to implement:
- 6 (A) Subchapter F, Chapter 2113, Government Code,
- 7 as added by this Act; and
- 8 (B) Section 140.008, Local Government Code, as
- 9 added by this Act.
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding Subchapter F, Chapter 2113, Government
- 11 Code, as added by this Act, or Section 140.008, Local Government
- 12 Code, as added by this Act, a person, including a state agency,
- 13 political subdivision of this state, nonprofit organization, or
- 14 public or private entity, is not required to comply with Subchapter
- 15 F or Section 140.008 or rules adopted under Subchapter F or Section
- 16 140.008 until January 1, 2012.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
