4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 658.005, Government Code, is amended by

6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to

7 read as follows:

8 Sec. 658.005. REGULAR OFFICE HOURS FOR STATE EMPLOYEES.

9 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), normal [Normal] office

10 hours of a state agency are from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through

11 Friday. These hours are the regular working hours for a full-time

12 state employee of an agency that is open five days each week.

13 (a-1) The chief administrator of a state agency may choose

14 to keep the agency open only four days each week, from Monday

15 through Thursday or from Tuesday through Friday. A state agency

16 that operates under this subsection is not required to provide

17 regular services from Friday through Sunday or from Saturday

18 through Monday, as applicable. The normal office hours of a state

19 agency that operates four days each week are from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.,

20 and those hours are the regular working hours for a full-time state

21 employee of the agency. The state agency shall publicize the

22 agency's business days and hours on the agency's Internet website.

23 (a-2) The offices of a state agency shall remain open during

24 the noon hour each working day with at least one person on duty to
