- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 351, Local Government
- 7 Code, is amended by adding Section 351.045 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 351.045. EMPLOYMENT OF HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS IN
- 9 CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) The commissioners court of a county with a
- 10 population of 3.3 million or more may appoint, contract for, or
- 11 employ licensed physicians, dentists, or other health care
- 12 providers to provide health care services to inmates in the custody
- 13 of the sheriff.
- 14 (b) This section may not be construed as authorizing a
- 15 commissioners court to supervise or control the practice of
- 16 medicine as prohibited by Subtitle B, Title 3, Occupations Code, or
- 17 to supervise or control the practice of dentistry as prohibited by
- 18 Subtitle D, Title 3, Occupations Code.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
