A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the authority of a dental hygienist to provide services 3 in certain facilities and schools. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Sections 262.1515(a) and (c), Occupations Code, 5 are amended to read as follows: 6 A licensed dentist may delegate a service, task, or 7 (a) procedure, pursuant to this section, to a dental hygienist, without 8 9 complying with Section 262.151(a)(2) if: (1) the dental hygienist has at least two years' 10 11 experience in the practice of dental hygiene; and (2) the service, task, or procedure is performed in 12 13 one of the following locations: 14 (A) a nursing facility as defined in Section 242.301, Health and Safety Code; 15 a school-based health center established 16 (B) under Subchapter B, Chapter 38, Education Code; [or] 17 18 (C) a community health center as defined by Section 136.002, Human Resources Code; or 19 20 (D) a public or private school or preschool, 21 including a facility in which a government-funded early child-care and education program is provided. 22 (c) A dental hygienist may only perform delegated tasks or 23 procedures with respect to a patient for 12 [six] months unless the 24

H.B. No. 1569 patient has been examined by a dentist in compliance with Section 1 262.151(a)(2). 2 SECTION 2. Section 262.152, Occupations Code, is amended to 3 4 read as follows: Sec. 262.152. PERFORMANCE OF DELEGATED DUTIES. Except as 5 6 provided by Section 262.1515, a dental hygienist shall practice dental hygiene: 7 in the dental office of a supervising dentist 8 (1) licensed by the board; or 9 in an alternate setting, including a nursing home, 10 (2) the patient's home, a school, a preschool, a hospital, a state 11 institution, a public health clinic, or another institution, under 12 the supervision of a supervising dentist. 13

14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
