- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.1826, Tax Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 7 (g) For purposes of determining whether an organization has
- 8 satisfied the requirements of Subsection (b) or (e) of this section
- 9 in order to qualify for an exemption under Section 11.1825 or
- 10 11.182, respectively, an opinion included in an audit of the
- 11 organization prepared by an independent auditor who is licensed by
- 12 this state as a certified public accountant or a determination of
- 13 tax-exempt status under Section 501(c), Internal Revenue Code of
- 14 1986, issued by the United States Internal Revenue Service is prima
- 15 <u>facie evidence of the facts stated in the opinion or determination.</u>
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to ad valorem taxes imposed
- 17 for a tax year beginning on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2012.
