Section 265.003(a), Occupations Code, is amended 10 11 to read as follows: 12 (a) A dental assistant who is not professionally licensed may [be employed by and] work in the office of a licensed and 13 14 practicing dentist and perform one or more delegated dental acts under: 15 (1) the direct 16 supervision, direction, and responsibility of the dentist, including: 17 the application of a pit and fissure sealant; 18 (A) (B) coronal polishing, if the dental assistant 19 holds a certificate under Section 265.006; and 20 21 (C) the application of fluoride varnish; or 22 (2) the general supervision, direction, and responsibility of the dentist, limited to: 23 the making of dental x-rays in compliance 24 (A)
