## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to disposition of fines imposed by certain municipalities
- 3 for traffic violations.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 542.402(b), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) In each fiscal year, a municipality having a population
- 8 of less than 5,000 may retain, from fines collected for violations
- 9 of this title and from special expenses collected under Article
- 10 45.051, Code of Criminal Procedure, in cases in which a violation of
- 11 this title is alleged, an amount equal to 30 percent of the
- 12 municipality's revenue for the preceding fiscal year from all
- 13 sources, other than federal funds and bond proceeds, as shown by the
- 14 audit performed under Section 103.001, Local Government Code.
- 15 After a municipality has retained that amount, the municipality
- 16 shall send to the comptroller any portion of a fine or a special
- 17 expense collected that exceeds \$1. This subsection does not apply
- 18 to a municipality in which less than 10 percent of the traffic
- 19 citations issued by peace officers of the municipality in the
- 20 preceding fiscal year were for driving five miles per hour or less
- 21 above the posted speed limit.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
