## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to notice of contract renewal or nonrenewal provided by a 3 school district to teachers employed under a term contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 21.206(a), Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:

7 (a) Not later than the <u>seventh</u> [45th] day <u>after</u> [before] the last day of instruction in a school year, the board of trustees 8 9 shall notify in writing each teacher whose contract is about to expire whether the board proposes to renew or not renew the 10 contract. The notice may be delivered personally to the teacher or 11 12 mailed by prepaid certified or registered mail to the teacher at the teacher's address of record with the district. Notice that is 13 14 mailed within the time specified by this subsection is considered timely for purposes of this section, regardless of the date the 15 16 notice is received by the teacher.

17 SECTION 2. If this Act takes effect on or before April 13, 18 2011, the change in law made by this Act applies beginning with 19 contracts for the 2011-2012 school year. If this Act takes effect 20 after April 13, 2011, the change in law made by this Act applies 21 beginning with contracts for the 2012-2013 school year.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
