- 2 relating to the renewal of electrical sign apprentice licenses.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1305.168(b-1), Occupations Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:

- 6 (b-1) To renew an electrical apprentice license or
- 7 <u>electrical sign apprentice license</u>, a license holder who is not
- 8 enrolled in an apprenticeship training program must complete four
- 9 hours of continuing education annually. Continuing education
- 10 courses that satisfy the requirements of this subsection must
- 11 address safety, the National Electrical Code, as adopted under
- 12 Section 1305.101, and state laws and rules that regulate the
- 13 conduct of license holders under this chapter.
- 14 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to the
- 15 renewal of an electrical sign apprentice license that expires on or
- 16 after September 1, 2012. A license that expires before September 1,
- 17 2012, is governed by the law in effect on the date the license was
- 18 issued, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
