- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 21.105(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) A teacher employed under a probationary contract for the
- 8 following school year may relinquish the position and leave the
- 9 employment of the district at the end of a school year without
- 10 penalty by filing with the board of trustees or its designee a
- 11 written resignation not later than the $\underline{60th}$ [45th] day before the
- 12 first day of instruction of the following school year. A written
- 13 resignation mailed by prepaid certified or registered mail to the
- 14 president of the board of trustees or the board's designee at the
- 15 post office address of the district is considered filed at the time
- 16 of mailing.
- SECTION 2. Section 21.160(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 18 read as follows:
- 19 (a) A teacher employed under a continuing contract may
- 20 relinquish the position and leave the employment of the district at
- 21 the end of a school year without penalty by filing with the board of
- 22 trustees or its designee a written resignation not later than the
- 23 60th [45th] day before the first day of instruction of the following
- 24 school year. A written resignation mailed by prepaid certified or

- 1 registered mail to the president of the board of trustees or the
- 2 board's designee at the post office address of the district is
- 3 considered filed at time of mailing.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 21.210(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) A teacher employed under a term contract with a school
- 7 district may relinquish the teaching position and leave the
- 8 employment of the district at the end of a school year without
- 9 penalty by filing a written resignation with the board of trustees
- 10 or the board's designee not later than the $\underline{60th}$ [45th] day before
- 11 the first day of instruction of the following school year. A
- 12 written resignation mailed by prepaid certified or registered mail
- 13 to the president of the board of trustees or the board's designee at
- 14 the post office address of the district is considered filed at the
- 15 time of mailing.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
