- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 209.008, Property Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (h) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by this section, a [A] property
- 9 owners' association may collect reimbursement of reasonable
- 10 attorney's fees and other reasonable costs incurred by the
- 11 association relating to collecting amounts, including damages, due
- 12 the association for enforcing restrictions or the bylaws or rules
- 13 of the association only if the owner is provided a written notice
- 14 that attorney's fees and costs will be charged to the owner if the
- 15 delinquency or violation continues after a date certain.
- 16 (h) Notwithstanding Subsection (f), an owner is not liable
- 17 for attorney's fees incurred by the property owners' association in
- 18 judicially or nonjudicially foreclosing the association's
- 19 assessment lien on the owner's property.
- 20 SECTION 2. (a) Except as provided by this section, the
- 21 change in law made by this Act applies only to a judicial
- 22 foreclosure in which an action is commenced or a nonjudicial
- 23 foreclosure in which a notice of default under Section 51.002,
- 24 Property Code, is given on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 A foreclosure in which an action is commenced or a notice of default
- 2 is given before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 3 law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 4 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 (b) The change in law made by this Act does not apply to
- 6 liability for attorney's fees incurred before the effective date of
- 7 this Act. Liability for attorney's fees incurred before the
- 8 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect
- 9 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 10 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
