4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 1376.003, Insurance Code,
6	is amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1376.003. MINIMUM COVERAGE REQUIRED: CERTAIN ADULTS.
8	SECTION 2. Chapter 1376, Insurance Code, is amended by
9	adding Section 1376.004 to read as follows:
10	Sec. 1376.004. MINIMUM COVERAGE REQUIRED: CERTAIN
11	CHILDREN. (a) A health benefit plan that provides coverage for
12	screening medical procedures must provide the minimum coverage
13	required by this section to each covered individual who is older
14	than 10 years of age and younger than 18 years of age and who:
15	(1) is a student at a middle school in Texas; or
16	(2) has not been diagnosed with heart disease and has
17	not undergone an electrocardiogram or echocardiogram within the
18	past two years.
19	(b) The minimum coverage required to be provided under this
20	section is coverage of up to \$150 for the following series of
21	examinations once every five years, performed by a physician and a
22	laboratory certified by a national organization recognized by the
23	commissioner by rule for the purposes of this section, and intended
24	to detect asymptomatic underlying congenital cardiovascular

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1 conditions that are associated with sudden cardiac arrest in children, including abnormal structure or function of the heart, 2 3 the arteries, or the electrical pathways in the heart: 4 (1) history documenting personal or family history 5 associated with sudden cardiac arrest; 6 (2) focused cardiovascular physical examination for 7 clues to underlying conditions associated with sudden cardiac 8 arrest, such as abnormal murmurs and body habitus; 9 (3) electrocardiogram measuring cardiac electrical activity and for the detection of those conditions associated with 10 sudden cardiac arrest; and 11 12 (4) limited five-minute echocardiography to detect those structural cardiovascular conditions associated with sudden 13 14 cardiac arrest in children. SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 15 to a health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed 16 17 on or after January 1, 2012. A health benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2012, is governed 18 by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this 19 Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose. 20 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
