(2) a disability caused by an impairment of vision as
provided by Section 681.001(2), the notarized written statement or
written prescription required by Subsection (c) may be issued by a
person licensed to engage in the practice of optometry or the

8 (3) a temporary mobility problem that substantially 9 impairs the person's ability to ambulate, the notarized written 10 statement or written prescription required by Subsection (c) may be 11 issued by a person licensed to practice chiropractic in this state 12 or a state adjacent to this state.

13(h) In this section, "chiropractic" has the meaning14assigned by Section 201.002, Occupations Code.
