A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to reporting donations received by a school district and
 3 public school campus.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 11.1561 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 11.1561. REPORT OF DONATIONS. (a) A school district
- 8 shall annually report all monetary and nonmonetary donations
- 9 received by the district and each school campus in the district in
- 10 the manner specified by the commissioner. The report must be
- 11 submitted through the Public Education Information Management
- 12 System (PEIMS) and include a statement of:
- 13 (1) the amount of any monetary donation;
- 14 (2) the fair market value and a description of any
- 15 nonmonetary donation;
- 16 (3) the name and location of the school campus, if the
- 17 donation was made to a campus; and
- 18 (4) any restrictions or conditions placed on the
- 19 <u>donation</u> by the donor.
- 20 (b) A report under this section must be posted on the
- 21 Internet website of the school district and school campus, if
- 22 applicable.

- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2011-2012
- 24 school year.

- 1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
