## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

| 4  | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:          |
| 5  | SECTION 1. Chapter 775, Health and Safety Code, is amended       |
| 6  | by adding Subchapter L to read as follows:                       |
| 7  | SUBCHAPTER L. CONSOLIDATION OF EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICTS      |
| 8  | IN CERTAIN COUNTIES                                              |
| 9  | Sec. 775.351. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only        |
| 10 | to a county:                                                     |
| 11 | (1) with a population of more than 1.5 million; and              |
| 12 | (2) that has in its boundaries 11 emergency services             |
| 13 | districts on January 1, 2011.                                    |
| 14 | Sec. 775.352. CONSOLIDATION OF EMERGENCY SERVICES                |
| 15 | DISTRICTS. (a) All districts located wholly in a county to which |
| 16 | this subchapter applies shall consolidate into a single district |
| 17 | according to this subchapter.                                    |
| 18 | (b) The boards of the districts shall adopt a joint order of     |
| 19 | consolidation that includes:                                     |
| 20 | (1) the name and territory of the consolidated                   |
| 21 | district; and                                                    |
| 22 | (2) the proposed date on which the former districts              |
| 23 | dissolve and the consolidated district is created and will start |
| 24 | offering services, which may not be before the date the          |

- 3 Sec. 775.353. ELECTION OF INITIAL BOARD. (a) Before the
- 4 former districts consolidate, the commissioners court shall order
- 5 an election to elect seven initial emergency services commissioners
- 6 at the next available uniform election date that allows sufficient
- 7 time to comply with other requirements of law.
- 8 (b) The commissioners court, at the time it orders the
- 9 election, shall order creation of seven election precincts in the
- 10 district and shall designate polling places in each precinct.
- 11 <u>(c) One emergency services commissioner is elected from</u>
- 12 each election precinct by the voters of that precinct.
- (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), emergency
- 14 services commissioners serve staggered two-year terms.
- (e) The initial emergency services commissioners shall
- 16 stagger their terms, with a majority of the commissioners serving
- 17 two years, and a minority of commissioners serving one year. If the
- 18 initial commissioners cannot agree on the staggering, the
- 19 commissioners shall draw lots to determine the commissioners who
- 20 serve one-year terms.
- Sec. 775.354. CONVERSION OF APPOINTED BOARD TO ELECTED
- 22 BOARD. An emergency services commissioner serving on the board of a
- 23 district in a county to which this subchapter applies immediately
- 24 before the date the joint order is adopted continues to carry out
- 25 the board's functions until the new commissioners for the
- 26 consolidated district are elected and qualified and the
- 27 <u>consolidated distri</u>ct is created.

- 1 Sec. 775.355. ELECTION OF BOARD. (a) The governing body of
- 2 a consolidated district created under this subchapter consists of a
- 3 seven-person board of emergency services commissioners elected as
- 4 prescribed by this section. Except as provided by Section 775.353,
- 5 an emergency services commissioner serves a two-year term.
- 6 (b) The election precincts created under Section 775.353
- 7 shall remain the election precincts of the district until changed
- 8 by an order of its board. One commissioner is elected from each
- 9 election precinct by the voters of the precinct.
- 10 (c) The general election for commissioners shall be held
- 11 annually on a uniform election date provided by Chapter 41,
- 12 Election Code.
- 13 Sec. 775.356. TAXES FOR CONSOLIDATED DISTRICT. (a) The
- 14 boards that adopt a joint order under Section 775.352 jointly shall
- 15 set a maximum tax rate throughout the consolidated district at a
- 16 rate that does not exceed the lowest maximum tax rate authorized for
- 17 any of the former districts.
- 18 (b) The board of the consolidated district may order an
- 19 election under Section 775.0745 or 775.0752, as appropriate, to
- 20 <u>authorize</u> the imposition of taxes throughout the consolidated
- 21 district at a rate that exceeds the lowest maximum tax rate
- 22 authorized for any of the former districts but does not exceed the
- 23 maximum tax rate authorized by this chapter. If the board conducts
- 24 an election under Section 775.0752, Section 775.0753 governs the
- 25 effective date of the resulting tax rate.
- Sec. 775.357. EFFECT OF CONSOLIDATION. The consolidated
- 27 district assumes all powers, rights, duties, assets, and

- 1 <u>liabilities</u> of the former districts without a change in
- 2 status. The consolidation does not diminish or impair the rights
- 3 of the holders of any outstanding and unpaid bonds, warrants, or
- 4 other obligations of the district.
- 5 SECTION 2. In a county to which Subchapter L, Chapter 755,
- 6 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, applies on the
- 7 effective date of this Act:
- 8 (1) the consolidation required by Section 775.352,
- 9 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, must take place as
- 10 soon as practicable after the date of an election held under Section
- 11 775.353(a), Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, and not
- 12 later than August 31, 2013; and
- 13 (2) the resulting consolidated district must be
- 14 created and start offering services not later than September 1,
- 15 2013.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
