1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the installation of a speed feedback sign by a property  
1-10 owners' association.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Chapter 430, Transportation Code, is amended by  
1-13 adding Section 430.002 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 430.002. SPEED FEEDBACK SIGNS ERECTED BY NEIGHBORHOOD  
1-15 ASSOCIATION. (a) In this section, "property owners' association"  
1-16 means an association described by Section 204.004, Property Code.

1-17 (b) A property owners' association may install a speed  
1-18 feedback sign on a road, highway, or street in the association's  
1-19 jurisdiction if:

1-20 (1) the association receives the consent of the  
1-21 governing body of the political subdivision that maintains the  
1-22 road, highway, or street for the placement of the sign; and

1-23 (2) the association pays for the installation of the  
1-24 sign.

1-25 (c) A property owners' association that installs a speed  
1-26 feedback sign under this section is responsible for the maintenance  
1-27 of the sign.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
