A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of a groundwater conservation district to
- 3 adopt different rules for the management of groundwater resources
- 4 located in different areas of the district.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Sections 36.001(6) and (7), Water Code, are
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (6) "Aquifer" or "groundwater ["Groundwater]
- 9 reservoir" means a specific subsurface water-bearing reservoir
- 10 having ascertainable boundaries containing groundwater.
- 11 (7) "Subdivision of an aquifer" or "subdivision of a
- 12 groundwater reservoir" means a definable part of a groundwater
- 13 reservoir in which the groundwater supply will not be appreciably
- 14 affected by withdrawing water from any other part of the reservoir,
- 15 as indicated by known geological and hydrological conditions and
- 16 relationships and on foreseeable economic development at the time
- 17 the subdivision is designated or altered.
- SECTION 2. Section 36.108(d), Water Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (d) Not later than September 1, 2010, and every five years
- 21 thereafter, the districts shall consider groundwater availability
- 22 models and other data or information for the management area and
- 23 shall establish desired future conditions for the relevant aquifers
- 24 within the management area. [In establishing the desired future

- 1 conditions of the aguifers under this section, the districts shall
- 2 consider uses or conditions of an aquifer within the management
- 3 area that differ substantially from one geographic area to
- 4 another. The districts may establish different desired future
- 5 conditions for[+
- 6 $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ each aquifer, subdivision of an aquifer, or
- 7 geologic strata located in whole or in part within the boundaries of
- 8 the management area[; or
- 9 [(2) each geographic area overlying an aquifer in
- 10 whole or in part or subdivision of an aquifer within the boundaries
- 11 of the management area].
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 36.116(d), Water Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (d) For better management of the groundwater resources
- 15 located in a district [or if a district determines that conditions
- 16 in or use of an aquifer differ substantially from one geographic
- 17 area of the district to another], the district may adopt different
- 18 rules for [+
- 19 $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ each aquifer, subdivision of an aquifer, or
- 20 geologic strata located in whole or in part within the boundaries of
- 21 the district[; or
- 22 [<u>(2) each geographic area overlying an aquifer or</u>
- 23 subdivision of an aquifer located in whole or in part within the
- 24 boundaries of the district].
- 25 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
