AN ACT

- 2 relating to contracts between dentists and health maintenance
- 3 organizations or insurers.

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- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 843, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 843.3115 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 843.3115. CONTRACTS WITH DENTISTS. A contract between
- 8 a health maintenance organization and a dentist may not limit the
- 9 fee the dentist may charge for a service for which an enrollee's
- 10 health care plan does not provide a benefit or reimbursement,
- 11 including a service that exceeds the annual or lifetime maximum
- 12 plan limit or that is provided during a waiting period.
- 13 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 1451, Insurance Code, is
- 14 amended by adding Section 1451.2065 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1451.2065. CONTRACTS WITH DENTISTS. A contract
- 16 between an insurer and a dentist may not limit the fee the dentist
- 17 may charge for a service for which a patient's employee benefit plan
- 18 or health insurance policy does not provide a benefit or
- 19 reimbursement, including a service that exceeds the annual or
- 20 lifetime maximum limit of the plan or policy or that is provided
- 21 during a waiting period.
- 22 SECTION 3. Sections 843.3115 and 1451.2065, Insurance Code,
- 23 as added by this Act, apply only to a contract entered into or
- 24 renewed on or after the effective date of this Act. A contract

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- 1 entered into or renewed before the effective date of this Act is
- 2 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 3 of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
