## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to requiring an interagency memorandum of understanding regarding the Public Assistance Reporting Information System and 3 the use of data from that system. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is 7 amended by adding Section 531.0998 to read as follows: Sec. 531.0998. MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING 8 PUBLIC ASSISTANCE REPORTING INFORMATION SYSTEM. (a) 9 In this section, "system" means the Public Assistance Reporting 10 Information System (PARIS) operated by the Administration for 11 12 Children and Families of the United States Department of Health and 13 Human Services. 14 (b) The commission, the Department of Aging and Disability Services, the Texas Veterans Commission, and the Veterans' Land 15 16 Board shall enter into a memorandum of understanding for the 17 purposes of: 18 (1) coordinating and collecting information about the use and analysis among state agencies of data received from the 19 system; and 20 21 (2) developing new strategies for state agencies to use system data in ways that generate fiscal savings for the state. 22 23 (c) Not later than October 15, 2012, the commission, the Department of Aging and Disability Services, the Texas Veterans 24

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Commission, and the Veterans' Land Board collectively shall submit 1 to the governor and the Legislative Budget Board a report 2 3 describing: 4 (1) the frequency and success with which state 5 agencies have used the system; 6 (2) the costs to the state that were avoided as a 7 result of state agencies' use of the system; and 8 (3) recommendations for future use of the system by 9 state agencies.

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10 (d) Subsection (c) and this subsection expire September 2, 11 2013.

12 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2011, the Health and 13 Human Services Commission, the Department of Aging and Disability 14 Services, the Texas Veterans Commission, and the Veterans' Land 15 Board shall enter into a memorandum of understanding as required by 16 Section 531.0998, Government Code, as added by this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.

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
