2	relating to emergency services districts.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 775, Health and Safety
5	Code, is amended by adding Section 775.0365 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 775.0365. BOARD TRAINING. (a) In this section,
7	"department" means the Texas Department of Rural Affairs.
8	(b) Each emergency services commissioner shall complete a
9	training course:
10	(1) for the commissioner's initial term, not later
11	than the earlier of:
12	(A) the 180th day after the date the commissioner
13	takes the oath of office; or
14	(B) the 180th day after the date the commissioner
15	assumes responsibilities as an emergency services commissioner;
16	and
17	(2) not later than the second anniversary of each date
18	the commissioner completes a training course.
19	(c) The department shall:
20	(1) determine the minimum course requirements; and
21	(2) make the course available.
22	(d) The department may provide the training course. The
23	department must approve any training course provided by an entity
24	other than the department.

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1	(e) The training course must provide instruction in:
2	(1) district responsibilities;
3	(2) board responsibilities;
4	(3) government administration;
5	(4) ethics laws relating to public officers; and
6	(5) the governance and management of emergency
7	services.
8	(f) The entity providing the training course shall provide a
9	certificate of course completion to each person who completes the
10	course.
11	(g) An emergency services commissioner who completes the
12	training course shall file a copy of the certificate of course
13	completion with the commissioners court of each county in which the
14	district is located not later than the 10th day after the date the
15	commissioner is required to complete the course under Subsection
16	<u>(b)</u> .
17	SECTION 2. The heading to Section 775.0422, Health and
18	Safety Code, is amended to read as follows:
19	Sec. 775.0422. REMOVAL OF APPOINTED BOARD MEMBER BY
20	COMMISSIONERS COURT [FOR FAILURE TO GIVE REPORT].
21	SECTION 3. Section 775.0422, Health and Safety Code, is
22	amended by amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection
23	(b-1) to read as follows:
24	(b) The commissioners court of the county in which a
25	district is located, by an order adopted by a majority vote after a
26	hearing, may remove one or more board members if the board failed to
27	give <u>a</u> [ <del>the</del> ] report required by Section <u>775.036</u> [ <del>775.036(a)(4)</del> ] to

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the commissioners court before the 91st day after the date on which
 the report <u>is</u> [was] due under that section.

3 (b-1) The commissioners court of the county in which a 4 district is located, by an order adopted by a majority vote after a 5 hearing, may remove a board member if the board member does not 6 complete a training course and file a copy of the certificate of 7 course completion as required by Section 775.0365. If the district 8 is located in more than one county, the commissioners court of each 9 county must adopt the order before the board member may be removed.

10 (c) Before the 60th day after the date on which the report <u>or</u> 11 <u>certificate of course completion is</u> [was] due, each commissioners 12 court seeking removal under this section must notify the board 13 members that it is considering that action.

SECTION 4. Section 775.074, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:

16 (d-1) The board may not set the tax rate for a fiscal year
17 before the date the board adopts a budget for that fiscal year.

SECTION 5. Section 775.082, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows:

20 <u>(e-1) When a district located wholly in one county fails to</u> 21 <u>complete and file the audit report by September 1 of each year and a</u> 22 <u>county auditor is not ordered to prepare the report, the board is</u> 23 <u>abolished and the commissioners court shall appoint a new board as</u> 24 <u>provided by Section 775.034.</u>

25 SECTION 6. Subchapter C, Chapter 776, Health and Safety 26 Code, is amended by adding Sections 776.0355 and 776.0356 to read as 27 follows:

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1	Sec. 776.0355. BOARD TRAINING. (a) In this section,

9 Sec. 776.0356. REMOVAL OF APPOINTED BOARD MEMBER ΒY COMMISSIONERS COURT. (a) The commissioners court of each county 10 in which a district is located, by an order adopted by a majority 11 12 vote after a hearing, may remove an appointed board member if the board member fails to complete a training course and file a copy of 13 14 the certificate of course completion as required by Section 15 776.0355. 16 (b) Before the 60th day after the date the certificate of

10 <u>(b)</u> Before the ooth ady after the date the certificate of 17 <u>completion is due, each commissioners court seeking removal under</u> 18 <u>this section must notify the board members that it is considering</u> 19 <u>that action.</u>

20 SECTION 7. Section 776.075, Health and Safety Code, is 21 amended by adding Subsection (d-1) to read as follows:

22 (d-1) The board may not set the tax rate for a fiscal year
23 before the date the board adopts a budget for that fiscal year.

24 SECTION 8. Section 775.024, Health and Safety Code, is 25 repealed.

26 SECTION 9. (a) In this section, "department" means the 27 Texas Department of Rural Affairs.

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(b) Not later than June 1, 2012, the department shall make
available a training course as required by Sections 775.0365 and
3 776.0355, Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act.

4 (c) The deadlines to take the course under Sections 775.0365(b) and 776.0355(b), Health and Safety Code, as added by 5 this Act, do not apply to an emergency services commissioner 6 appointed or elected to a board of emergency services commissioners 7 8 for a term that starts before June 1, 2012. Not later than the 180th day after the date the department makes available a training course 9 under Subsection (b) of this section, an emergency services 10 commissioner described by this subsection must complete the course. 11

12 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it 13 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each 14 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 15 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate 16 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
