3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 104.103(b), Utilities Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(b) Instead of publishing newspaper notice, a gas utility
7	may provide notice [to the public in an area outside the affected
8	municipality or in a municipality with a population of less than
9	<del>2,500</del> ] by:
10	(1) mailing the notice by United States mail, postage
11	prepaid, to the billing address of each directly affected customer;
12	[ <del>or</del> ]
13	(2) including the notice, in conspicuous form, in the
14	bill of each directly affected customer; or
15	(3) sending the notice by e-mail to each directly
16	affected customer if that address is available to the utility.
17	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
18	to a notice of a proposed utility rate increase provided on or after
19	the effective date of this Act. Notice provided before the
20	effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed
21	immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
22	continued in effect for that purpose.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
