- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1301.552, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1301.552. CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE FOR PLUMBING PERMIT
- 8 IN POLITICAL SUBDIVISION. A political subdivision that requires a
- 9 plumbing contractor to obtain a permit before performing plumbing
- 10 in the political subdivision shall verify through the board's
- 11 Internet website, or by contacting the board by telephone, that the
- 12 plumbing contractor has on file with the board a certificate of
- 13 insurance. The certificate of insurance must:
- 14 (1) be written by an insurer authorized to engage in
- 15 the [a company licensed to do] business of insurance in this state
- 16 or an eligible surplus lines insurer, as defined by Section
- 17 981.002, Insurance Code;
- 18 (2) provide for commercial general liability
- 19 insurance for the master plumber for a claim for property damage or
- 20 bodily injury, regardless of whether the claim arises from
- 21 negligence or on a contract; and
- 22 (3) provide coverage of not less than \$300,000 for all
- 23 claims arising in a one-year period.
- 24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section

- 1 1301.552, Occupations Code, applies only to a permit issued on or
- 2 after the effective date of this Act. A permit issued before the
- 3 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 4 date the permit is issued, and the former law is continued in effect
- 5 for that purpose.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
