- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 2051.0441(a) and (b), Government Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) This section applies only to a notice published \underline{by} a
- 8 governmental entity or representative in a county:
- 9 (1) with a population of at least 30,000 and not more
- 10 than 36,000 that borders the Red River; or
- 11 (2) that does not have a newspaper described by
- 12 <u>Section 2051.044 published in the county</u> [by a governmental entity
- 13 or representative].
- 14 (b) The newspaper in which a notice is published under this
- 15 section must:
- 16 (1) devote not less than 20 percent of its total column
- 17 lineage to general interest items;
- 18 (2) be published at least once each week;
- 19 (3) be entered as <u>periodical</u> [<u>second-class</u>] postal
- 20 matter in the county where published or have a mailed or delivered
- 21 circulation of at least 51 percent of the residences in the county
- 22 where published; and
- 23 (4) have been published regularly and continuously for
- 24 at least 12 months before the governmental entity or representative

- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
