- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 67.0105, Water Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 67.0105. [CONTRACT FOR] WATER FOR FIRE SUPPRESSION.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 67.0105, Water Code, is amended by
- 10 amending Subsections (a) and (c) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (a) A corporation may provide a water supply to a
- 13 municipality or volunteer fire department for use in fire
- 14 suppression.
- 15 (a-1) A corporation may enter into a contract with a
- 16 municipality or a volunteer fire department to supply water either
- 17 to municipally owned fire hydrants or to corporation fire hydrants
- 18 for use in fire suppression by the municipality's fire department
- 19 or a volunteer fire department. The contract must be under terms
- 20 that are mutually beneficial to the contracting parties.
- (c) A corporation that provides [contracts with] a
- 22 municipality or volunteer fire department [to provide] a water
- 23 supply or fire hydrant equipment to carry out the governmental
- 24 function described by Subsection (b) may be liable for damages only

- 1 to the extent that the municipality or volunteer fire department
- 2 would be liable if the municipality or volunteer fire department
- 3 were performing the governmental function directly.
- 4 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 5 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 6 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- 7 of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that
- 8 date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
