H.B. No. 1819

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the Aldine Improvement District; providing authority to 3 impose a tax. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 3817, Special District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 CHAPTER 3817. <u>EAST</u> ALDINE MANAGEMENT [HMPROVEMENT] DISTRICT 7 SECTION 2. Section 3817.001(2), Special District Local Laws 8 9 Code, is amended to read as follows: (2) "District" means the 10 East Aldine Management 11 [Improvement] District. 12 SECTION 3. Section 3817.002, Special District Local Laws 13 Code, is amended to read as follows: 14 Sec. 3817.002. EAST ALDINE MANAGEMENT [IMPROVEMENT] DISTRICT. The East Aldine Management [Improvement] District is a 15 special district created under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas 16 Constitution. 17 18 SECTION 4. Section 3817.005(b), Special District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows: 19 (b) The boundaries and field notes of the district 20 [contained in Section 1, Chapter 1433, Acts of the 77th 21 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, enacting former Section 22 23 376.454, Local Government Code,] form a closure. A mistake in the field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process 24

1 does not in any way affect the district's:

organization, existence, or validity;

3 (2) right to issue any type of bond for a purpose for 4 which the district is created or to pay the principal of and 5 interest on the bond;

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(3) right to impose or collect an assessment or tax; or(4) legality or operation.

8 SECTION 5. Section 3817.154, Special District Local Laws 9 Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection 10 (e) to read as follows:

(a) The district may impose a sales and use tax if authorized by a majority of the voters of the district voting at an election called for that purpose. Revenue from the tax may be used for any purpose for which [ad valorem tax] revenue of the district may be used.

16 (e) The board may establish one or more areas in the 17 district as a special sales and use tax zone if the board finds that a reasonable distinction exists that justifies a special sales and 18 19 use tax rate in the area. The special sales and use tax rate may be different than the sales and use tax rate imposed in the rest of the 20 district if the special sales and use tax rate is approved by a 21 majority of the voters of the special sales and use tax zone at an 22 23 election held for that purpose.

24 SECTION 6. The following territory is added to the 25 territory of the East Aldine Management District, formerly known as 26 the Aldine Improvement District:

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Tract 1-BEGINNING at the northwestern corner of the boundary

of the East Aldine Management District at the north right of way of
 Aldine Bender Road and the east boundary of Greater Greenspoint
 Management District;

THENCE, northerly along the east boundary of Greater
Greenspoint Management District to the southern boundary of Greens
Parkway Municipal Utility District ("GPMUD");

7 THENCE, east along the southern boundary of GPMUD to the 8 point at which the GPMUD boundary turns north at the right of way of 9 Greens Road;

10 THENCE, continuing east along the north right of way of 11 Greens Road to the intersection of Greens Road and the City of 12 Houston full-purpose boundary line;

13 THENCE, south along the City of Houston full-purpose boundary 14 line, across Beltway 8 to the point at which the City of Houston 15 full-purpose boundary line intersects the northern boundary of East 16 Aldine Management District at Aldine Bender Road;

17 THENCE, west along the northern boundary line of East Aldine18 Management District, TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

19 Tract 2-BEGINNING at the point at which the northern boundary 20 line of the East Aldine Management District intersects the City of 21 Houston full-purpose boundary line on the east side of the right of 22 way of Aldine Bender Road;

THENCE, north along the City of Houston full-purpose boundary line to the point at which the City of Houston full-purpose boundary line turns east;

THENCE, generally east along the City of Houston full-purpose boundary line to the point at which the City of Houston full-purpose

1 boundary line reaches the right of way of John F. Kennedy Boulevard,
2 then south along the same City of Houston full-purpose boundary
3 line to the right of way of Aldine Bender Road where it meets the
4 north boundary line of East Aldine Management District;

5 THENCE, west along the north boundary line of East Aldine 6 Management District, to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

7 Tract 3-BEGINNING at the point at which the western boundary 8 line of the East Aldine Management District intersects the north 9 easement of Harris County Flood Control District (HCFCD) drainage 10 ditch (#9 DD-7, P138-00-00 tributary 24.97 to Greens Bayou);

11 THENCE, westerly along the north easement of HCFCD drainage 12 ditch (#9 DD-7, P138-00-00 tributary 24.97 to Greens Bayou) to east 13 boundary of City of Houston full-purpose boundary line;

14 THENCE, south along east boundary of City of Houston 15 full-purpose boundary line, across HCFCD easement of drainage ditch 16 (#9 DD-7, P138-00-00 tributary 24.97 to Greens Bayou) to north 17 boundary of Colonial Hills Subdivision

18 THENCE, west along the north boundary of Colonial Hills 19 Subdivision to northwest corner of said subdivision;

THENCE, southerly along the west boundary of Colonial Hills
Subdivision to southwest corner of said subdivision;

THENCE east along the south boundary of Colonial Hills Subdivision to southeast corner of said subdivision;

THENCE, north along the east boundary of Colonial Hills Subdivision to northeast corner of said subdivision and south easement of HCFCD drainage ditch (#9 DD-7, P138-00-00 tributary 27 24.97 to Greens Bayou);

1 THENCE easterly along the south easement of HCFCD drainage 2 ditch (#9 DD-7, P138-00-00 tributary 24.97 to Greens Bayou) to west 3 boundary of existing East Aldine Management District;

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THENCE, north along west boundary of existing East Aldine Management District, across easement of HCFCD drainage ditch (#9 DD-7, P138-00-00 tributary 24.97 to Greens Bayou), to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

8 SECTION 7. (a) The legislature validates and confirms all governmental acts and proceedings of the Aldine Improvement 9 District, now known as the East Aldine Management District, that 10 were taken before the effective date of this Act. An act or 11 proceeding may not be held invalid because the act or proceeding was 12 not in accordance with Chapter 3817, Special District Local Laws 13 14 Code, or other law.

15 (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the 16 effective date of this Act:

(1) is involved in litigation if the litigation ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final court judgment; or

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(2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment.

21 SECTION 8. A reference in law to the Aldine Improvement 22 District means the East Aldine Management District.

23 SECTION 9. (a) The legal notice of the intention to 24 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 25 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 26 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 27 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished

under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
 Government Code.

3 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has 4 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on 5 Environmental Quality.

6 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed 7 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, 8 lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives 9 within the required time.

10 (d) The general law relating to consent by political 11 subdivisions to the creation of districts with conservation, 12 reclamation, and road powers and the inclusion of land in those 13 districts has been complied with.

(e) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act have been
fulfilled and accomplished.

18 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it 19 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each 20 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 21 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate 22 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
