- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 38.028 to read as follows:

- 8 PRACTICES. (a) In this section:
- 9 (1) "Phase I environmental site assessment" means an

- 11 (2) "Phase II environmental site assessment" means an
- 12 assessment that complies with ASTM Standard E1903.
- 13 (b) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, in
- 14 coordination with the agency, shall conduct a study of school
- 15 district practices regarding selection of sites for new school
- 16 campuses.

- 17 (c) The study must include evaluation of:
- 18 (1) the extent to which school districts conduct Phase
- 19 <u>I or Phase II environmental site assessments;</u>
- 20 (2) for school districts that conduct Phase I or Phase
- 21 II environmental site assessments, the manner in which the
- 22 districts pay the costs of the assessments;
- 23 (3) the point in the selection process at which school
- 24 districts involve members of the public and the manner provided for

- 1 that involvement; and
- 2 (4) the environmental criteria that school districts
- 3 take into consideration in the selection process.
- 4 (d) Not later than December 1, 2012, the Texas Commission on
- 5 Environmental Quality and the agency shall complete the study
- 6 required by this section and submit a report containing the
- 7 findings of the study to the governor, the lieutenant governor, and
- 8 <u>each member of the legislature.</u>
- 9 (e) This section expires January 1, 2013.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
