5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 36, Utilities Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 36.066 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 36.066. ALLOWANCE OF EXPENSES RELATED TO ELECTRIC CAR
8	RECHARGING STATIONS. (a) A regulatory authority shall allow as
9	reasonable and necessary expenses an electric utility's
10	expenditures related to recharging stations for electric vehicles
11	to the extent the expenditures qualify for inclusion under
12	Subsection (b).
13	(b) To qualify for inclusion as a reasonable and necessary
14	expense for ratemaking purposes, an electric utility's expenditure
15	must be made:
16	(1) with a business incorporated or formed in this
17	state and located in this state; and
18	(2) for equipment, a good, or a service necessary for
19	planning, designing, constructing, installing, or maintaining for
20	the electric utility a recharging station:

use; and

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wholly or substantially produced or assembled at a location in this

(A) for electric vehicles designed for roadway

(B) the core functional components of which are

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- 1 state by a business incorporated or formed in this state.
- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2011.
